

#### **Tabiat Bridge**

This bridge is a newly constructed bridge and a manifestation of the architectural art. It is the largest pedestrian overpass in Iran connects two big public parks in northern parts of Tehran. The word tabiat means "nature" in the Persian language. Wide range of restaurants makes it a place for people to stay not just pass. Some have described walking on the bridge as feeling like walking through a forest and a place of positive energy.

#### Darband

Darband, formerly a village is a neighborhood inside Tehran's metropolitan limits. It is the beginning of a popular hiking trail into Mount Tochal, which towers over Tehran. A chairlift is also available for those not interested in hiking. The Persian term Darband translates to "door of the mountain". The initial start of the trail at Darband is about 250



meters long and is dotted with a number of small cafes and restaurants. These are quite popular and are busy in the evenings, as locals and tourists visit.

#### **Milad Tower**



The Milad Tower is a multi-purpose building, proudly standing on the north of Tehran and visible from almost every part of the city. It is the tallest tower in Iran and the sixth-tallest in the world. It provides not only a bird'seye view of the city but also some business activities and entertainment events. For regular visitors the main interest is the observation deck, located on the top of the head structure. It provides a panoramic 360-degree view of the city and mountains. Besides, you can visit art gallery and museum of the tower. When you are on the top, you can



visit a revolving restaurant, providing breakfast, lunch and dinner menu and an amazing opportunity to watch the city going around under your feet.
